**Text:** Titus 1  
**Title:** God of Truth, People of Truth

---

Titus was a Gentile believer. He was also mentioned by the Apostle Paul in his other letters, often described as a trusted and capable co-worker who fulfilled various ministries under difficult circumstances. In this letter, Paul instructed Titus to deal with the problems of false teachings in the church in Crete by appointing elders to uphold the truth and refute falsehood. The letter also contained instructions on how God's people ought to conduct themselves. Because the books of 1 Timothy and Titus addressed similar themes, it is likely that they were written close together, probably between AD 63 to AD 65.
