INTRODUCTION

What is the purpose of redemption?

1. A Personal Relationship
2. A Powerful Witness
3. A Positive Affirmation

1. A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP

Paul says “I beseech you, therefore by the mercies of God that you present yourselves as a living sacrifice...”

It begins as living sacrifice, resulting in a new creation/life.

2. A POWERFUL WITNESS

- Redemption is not just having a vertical relationship.
- There is a horizontal relationship too.
- Our lives are powerful witnesses for the Lord.
- “Not conforming to the world but transforming our minds”.

3. A POSITIVE AFFIRMATION

- The world we live in is full of uncertainty.
- No way can we predict the future, not even afterwards.
- Paul realised we have a positive affirmation for our life.
- “God’s will is good, perfect and complete”.
- The life of Joseph in the Old Testament.
- The testimony of Joshua in chapter 4 – “The memorial stones”.
